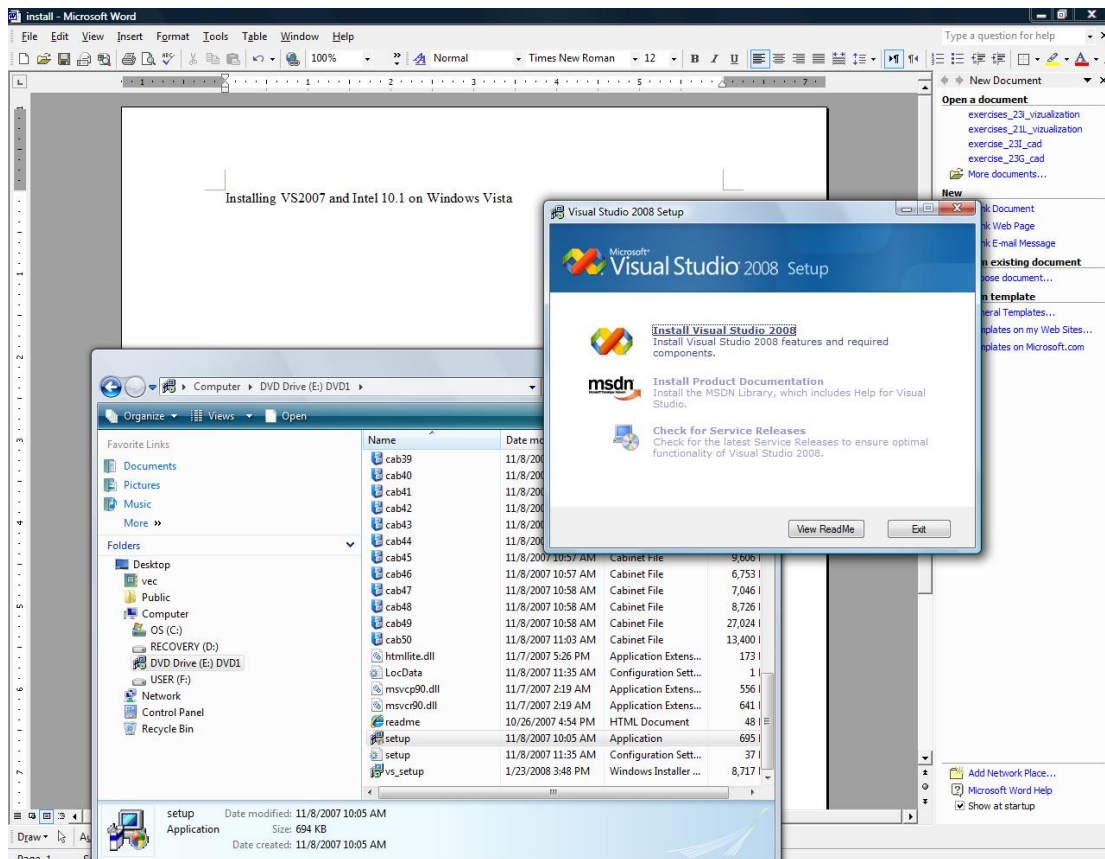

I have also done the following: #ifdef _WIN32 #include #else #endif #include Is there anything else I need to do to solve this problem? Thanks. A: If you're using Visual Studio 2010, have you already installed a patch to make sure that alloca.h is properly detected by the preprocessor (i.e., isn't treated as a macro)? Also, you might want to check that your allocator doesn't require malloc at all -- that is, are you using either _malloc_dbg_check or _malloc_dbg_fail?
